Re: Information on Racing in Yorkton for 2010

Horsemen,

I hope that everyone has had an enjoyable winter and are beginning to prepare for the race meet in Yorkton this coming summer. It's hard to believe that we will be back racing in less than 3 months!

We have been advised by SLGA that the final announcement on race dates and purses will not be until the end of March. We have been advised to continue preparing as we would normally do and they have suggested that opening day will be May 21 or 28, 2010.

The barns in Yorkton will be available for Spring training starting on **Saturday, April 10<sup>th</sup>**. Depending on the weather, the track will have the snow blown onto the infield again this year which seemed to help with the drying process and frost boils. Please call before you ship to verify that the track is useable.

Again this year, trainers are responsible for stall rent for horses under their training. Cost will be \$1.50 per day as in 2009. This includes spring training. We have purchased 20 box stalls which will be setup in the steel barn on the north-east corner of the track. These will be used for trainers staying through the summer meet. Outdoor lean-to stalls will be used only if required. Ship-ins or short stay horses may be assigned outdoor stalls if horse numbers dictate.

Please fill out the stall application included in this package and fax or mail in as soon as possible. Also any outstanding invoices have been included with your stall application. Owners will be receiving invoices if the invoice is in their names. If there is an issue with the invoice or you require further details, please call the office.

We look forward to another 16 days of great racing and hope you will join us this year in Yorkton.
